Four Man Team Scramble at Holmes/Pioneers

The Lincoln Senior Men's Golf League 'Fun in the Fall' Series hosted a 4-Man Team Scramble event on Wednesday September 21, 2011. The field of 128 golfers was too large to accommodate at Holmes so 32 men were sent to Pioneers to compete in the same event. The field was initially flighted by the handicap of the lowest handicap player on each team. Teams were organized by the computer within a system to equalize team handicaps within flights. The competition should be reasonably equal within flights.

In this format, best ball, all players hit from each tee. After the team chooses the best tee shot, ALL players on a team hit their next shot from that location. Balls may be placed within a club length, no nearer to the hole. If the tee shot landed off the fairway the ball must be placed off the fairway. All subsequent shots use the same procedure. On the greens place within 6 inches, no closer to the hole.

Players who normally hit from the blue tees should hit from the BLUE tees. If they normally hit from the white tees, hit from the WHITE tees. There will be no number of required tee shots by each player. If you have a good horse, ride him. Temperatures and conditions placed this day within the top ten days for golf in Nebraska.

At the end of play at Holmes Park golf Course, Winners of the first flight were the team of Jim Augustyn, Carl Hutchison, Ned Hedges and Ron Girard with a team score of 6 under par 66. The second flight was taken by the team of Bill Rondeau, Leroy Novak, Bob Schroeder and Jack Reighard, with a 67. Third flight honors went to Bill Rainey, Bill Westlund, John DuPont and Al Delano also with a 67. Winner of flight 4, played at Pioneers were the team of Gus Dorbusch, Pete Kalnins, Jim Shook and Lee Stubblefield with a 68. . No Picture of the winners at Pioneers.
