

TWO MAN TEAM SCRAMBLE AT IRON HORSE

One hundred and thirty two men drove to Ashland to participate in a 2-Man Team Scramble at Iron Horse Golf Club on Wednesday, October 5, 2011. The weather was about perfect for Golf, temperature in the 70's, and sunny with a bit of wind at the 10am shotgun start. Players could make up their own teams and the event was handicapped. Using the current league handicaps, a 'team handicap' was calculated using 60% of the lowest handicap and 40 % of the Highest handicap. Teams were flighted according to the resultant number and "strokes" were given within each flight as appropriate.

In the Scramble format both players hit from each tee. After choosing the tee shot to use both members of the team hit the next shot from that location. Balls may be placed within a club length, no nearer to the hole, of the location where the ball has come to rest. If the ball came to rest in a bunker the next shot must be from the bunker. If the chosen ball was off the green the next shot cannot be from on the green. All subsequent shots are subject to the same procedure. All puts must be holed.

Players should play from the same colored tees as they do in league play. The LEAF rule is in effect. If you cannot find your ball in a leaf strewn area, you may suspend your search and play another ball WITHOUT taking a penalty stroke. The next lucky guy who steps on your ball will appreciate two things; (1) the ball and (2) not having to wait .

At the end of play, the winners of flight 1 were Dave Neuhaus and Steve Kahler with a 64, Flight 2 was taken by Bob Westlund and Shorty Harris with a score of 66, Flight 3 winners were Wes Galligan and Don Corbin with a 68. Flight 4 was won by the team of Mike West and Leroy Novak with a 69. Flight 5 winners were Dave Bridges and Joe Swenson with a 72 and Flight 6 winners were LeeThiessey and Jim Augustyn with a team score of 77. GREAT SHOOTING on a day in October, in Nebraska
