## **LINCOLN SENIOR MEN'S LEAGUE READY FOR 2011 GOLF SEASON**

**The Lincoln Senior Men's Golf League elected its governing Board at its Annual Meeting in August of 2010.

The Senior Men's League is made up of 323 members, and substitutes, handicapped into 2-man teams, who are divided into 8 to 12 divisions by handicap. They compete for 11 weeks of league play, on Wednesday mornings on the Golf Courses at Pioneers, Highlands, Holmes, Mahoney and Wilderness Ridge and spend 5 weeks participating in "fun days" at other "local Courses" (i.e., Omaha, Nebraska City, Beatrice, Ashland) as well as other Lincoln courses (Yankee Hills, Woodland Hills, Firethorn, etc.) In Addition, the League holds two fund raising events at the Jim Ager Junior Golf Course.

The League consists of and welcomes players of all ability levels. Final 2010 league handicaps for individual players ranged from 5 to 50. The handicap system and the arrangement of divisions' guarantees that you be competing with other players of similar abilities regardless of your handicap.

The first League event of the season is a warm-up scramble at the Jim Ager Memorial Junior Golf Course, on Wednesday, April 13, 2011. A chance to get your clubs out, after a long winter, and get some practice on a short course. About halfway through the League schedule, in mid- June, a Senior/Junior Scramble is held on the same course. In these events, the City waives the green fees, and items are solicited from Local businesses to be used for prizes, so that all of the entry fees can be donated to the Junior Golf Program in Lincoln. As a result, over the years the Senior Men's Golf League has contributed over \$20,000 to the Junior Golf Course, the Junior Golf Program and to individual junior golfers. The seniors have fun, and the resulting contributions have been extraordinarily beneficial.

The organizational meeting for the 2011 season will be held at 10:00 am on Wednesday, March 9, 2011, at the Auld Recreational Center in Antelope Park, 3149 Sumner. Although attendance is not required, senior golfers (50+) are urged to attend, fill out an application form, join the League, get the latest information about golf in Lincoln from the City Pros' and participate in a fun season with your friends. If you do not have a partner, we have many individuals looking for a partner and we will pair you up with a man with similar handicap. You will meet lots of men who will soon become your golfing buddies.

Team memberships are unchanged at \$25 per person. Substitute membership fee is \$15 per person. These fees pay for League expenses, a free lunch banquet on the last day of the season and final League prizes. The membership fees do not include any green fees or cart/entry fees for "fun days", (usually \$5 for a prize money pot)

Registration Deadline is April 11, 2011 for teams. Substitutes may join at any time.
