The rules for this type of event were simple: both players hit from each tee. The team chooses which ball to play and both players hit their second shot from that location and continue to play their own ball throughout the hole, on each hole. The team score was the best NET score of the two team members on each hole. The NET score is the actual score minus the 'handicap strokes' on that hole. Handicap strokes were shown on the scorecard, for each player on each hole. Teams were flighted by total team handicap.

At the end of play, as the golfers were sitting around the clubhouse or waiting for their favorite beverage, the scores were being posted. The winners of the first flight with a score of 60 on this par 72 course were the team of Jerry Peterson and Bill Rondeau. Second Flight winners team of Don Corbin and Doc Ellis, with a 67. Third Flight honors went to the team of Bob Jacobs and Al Voge who shot a 57. Fourth flight was taken by Verdell Schramm and Fred Holbert with a score of 56, the low score of the day, 16 under par.
