

## **Lincoln Senior Men's League holds end of season Drop Out Scramble at Highlands and Pioneers Golf Courses and recognizes members for Hole-in-One scores in 2011**

On Wednesday, August 31, 144 men gathered at the Highlands Golf Course , and another 68 men traveled to Pioneers Golf Course to participate in a huge 4-Man DROP Out Scramble. This event was originally scheduled for Highlands but the field got so big that Pioneers was selected as an overflow site. This was also the day of the Annual meeting and a ' free lunch' was provided at Highlands. The lunch was paid for by the member dues. In order to accommodate the golfers, the tee times were a 7:30am shotgun start at Pioneers and an 8am shotgun start at the Highlands. This would allow the men at Pioneers to finish and get to the Highlands and have a chance to be first in line for the burgers.

In this format all four players hit from the tee on each hole. After choosing the tee shot to use, the player whose shot was chosen 'drops out' for the next shot and the other three men on the team hit their next shot from the spot of the chosen ball. When you got dropped it is ONLY FOR ONE SHOT, not for the rest of the hole. After the players have hit their second shot the team chooses which of those shots to use and the member of the team whose shot was not used play the ball from that location. The player whose was chosen is dropped from the next shot. Follow the same procedure for each shot, including putts until the ball is holed. All men hit from the next tee. After that only three players hit shots

All players will hit from the tees they used during this year's regular League competition. The computer formed the teams from among those signed up in such a way that the 'average' handicap of teams in each flight should be very close. In spite of all the planning there may be some teams with only three players. In these cases, teams played a three man scramble.

During the season there were six men who had Holes-In-One scores in league play, they are , alphabetically; Ron Girard, Gil Karges, Paul Liess, Rich Phillips, Ed Svendsen and Marion Tatum. See picture.

While the multitudes were consuming hundreds of pounds of food, the golf coordinators were posting the scores and determining the Drop-Out-Winners.
